EQUAL OPPORTUNITY POLICY FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Ch. Brahm Prakash Government Engineering College (CBPGEC) is a degree level college under the Administrative Control of Department of Training and Technical Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi. CBPGEC is committed to educate mainly in two fields of Bachelor of Technology i.e. Civil Engineering and Information Technology and it is affiliated to Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, Delhi.

I. Policy :

CBPGEC follows intimation of Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi issued from time to time, with reference to empowerment of persons with disabilities (PWD). It has been the endeavour of the Institute to maintain conducive and harmonious work environment to ensure that the persons with disabilities enjoy the right to equality, life and dignity and respect for his/her integrity equally with others.

II. Equal opportunity for persons with disabilities:


In accordance with the provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and Rules, the college strives to provide opportunities and facilities to persons with disabilities to participate, perform and excel in their work on an equal basis in everyday life.

The College provides reservation in appointments, as per GNCTD instructions/ guidelines issued from time to time, against posts which are identified for persons with disabilities, in keeping with the spirit of the State Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities, GNCTD in the matter. The candidates with necessary disability certificate issued by the competent authority in accordance with the Act are considered for the identified positions.

The persons with disabilities are encouraged to attend trainings as and when required to enhance their capabilities to enable them to effectively discharge their duties in the Institute. The request of persons with disabilities in intra-transfer/posting are supportively considered to the extent possible, for optimally utilizing their services. CBPGEC has user friendly environment for persons with disability. It has three-storey building with provision of lift to facilitate accessibility. Disabled friendly toilet facilities are available for both genders.

CBPGEC has appointed Sh. Raj Hans Tyagi, Private Secretary as Liaison Officer to look after the work/matter/issue of persons with disabilities and provisions of facilities and amenities for such employees. The Liaison Officer is being deputed for training as and when organized on disability, equality and etiquettes for efficient discharge of duties. Liaison Officer has mandated to keep the records of persons with disability as per the form and manner as prescribed in Chapter IV, Rule 9 of "Rights of Persons with Disabilities, Rule 2017".

This college has also designated Dr. Athar Hussain, Associate Professor/ Dean (Student Welfare) as Grievance Redressal Officer for the purpose of receiving and disposing of complaints from persons with disabilities. The Grievance Redressal Officer has mandated to keep the records of complaints etc. as per Rule 10 of "Rights of Persons with Disabilities, Rule 2017".




